### **Assistant Program and Apprentice Program**

This program is open to any current EHS Theatre Department high school participant. ### **Assistant Program:**

Our Assistants are really what will make the summer run smoothly. They are there everyday, Monday thru Friday. An Assistant organizes breaks, runs games, and is in charge when we break into small groups. This is a great opportunity for someone who is thinking about directing, teaching, or being involved in any type of leadership role in the future. The Assistants can expect to play a very big part in the Set Design, Costumes, Makeup Design, Sound and Lighting. There is a stipend paid for this position. The amount depends on performance, success of show, the director's recommendation, etc.

### **Apprentice Program:**

An Apprentice will work along side the Assistant and learn the technical aspects of theatre while working on projects for the show. The Apprentices will learn about Set Design, Lights, Sound, Costumes and Makeup Design. There is no cost to be an Apprentice and it looks great on a college or scholarship application! The Apprentices are not paid, but depending on performance a bonus may be given at the end of the program.

Daily time frame for both programs: Monday through Friday, 8:30 am till 4:30 pm.
